- Cutting-edge equipment is essential for saving wounded soldiers on the battlefield, quickly and efficiently.
- Budget to equip paramedical staff with a complete set of state-of-the-art equipment: €5,000/paramedic.

WAVE 1 - reminder

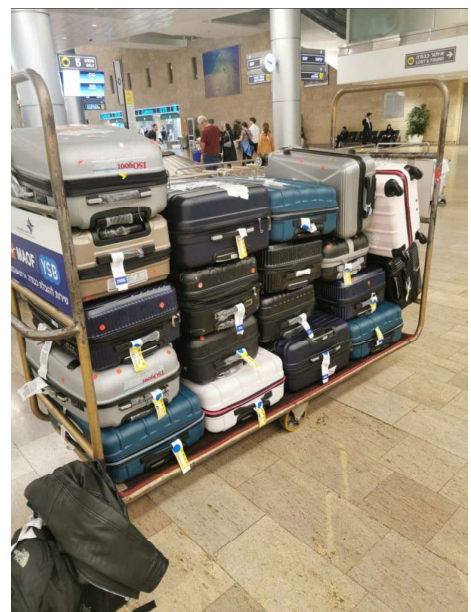
October 2023: we have rapidly set up an efficient logistics chain by purchasing from approved suppliers, then transport and distribution to the units

Equipment purchased for wave 1:

- 250 [tourniquets](#)
- 520 [CELOX gauze pads](#)
- 1,000 [dressings for chest wounds](#)
- 2,000 [chest decompression needles](#)

Total budget: 79.000€

WAVE 2 - reminder

December 2023: we have capitalized on the supply chain of wave 1 to increase the catalog of items and supply the IDF units more efficiently

Equipment purchased for wave 2:

- **21 items including:** Celox gauze, Pocket BVM, Capnograph, QuickTrach cricothyrotomy kit, Complete set of trocars, Chest drain kit, Chest Seal Vented, Complete EZ IO adalat kit, Pulseoxymeter, Heating panel,...

Total budget: 92.000€

Total budget: 110.000€

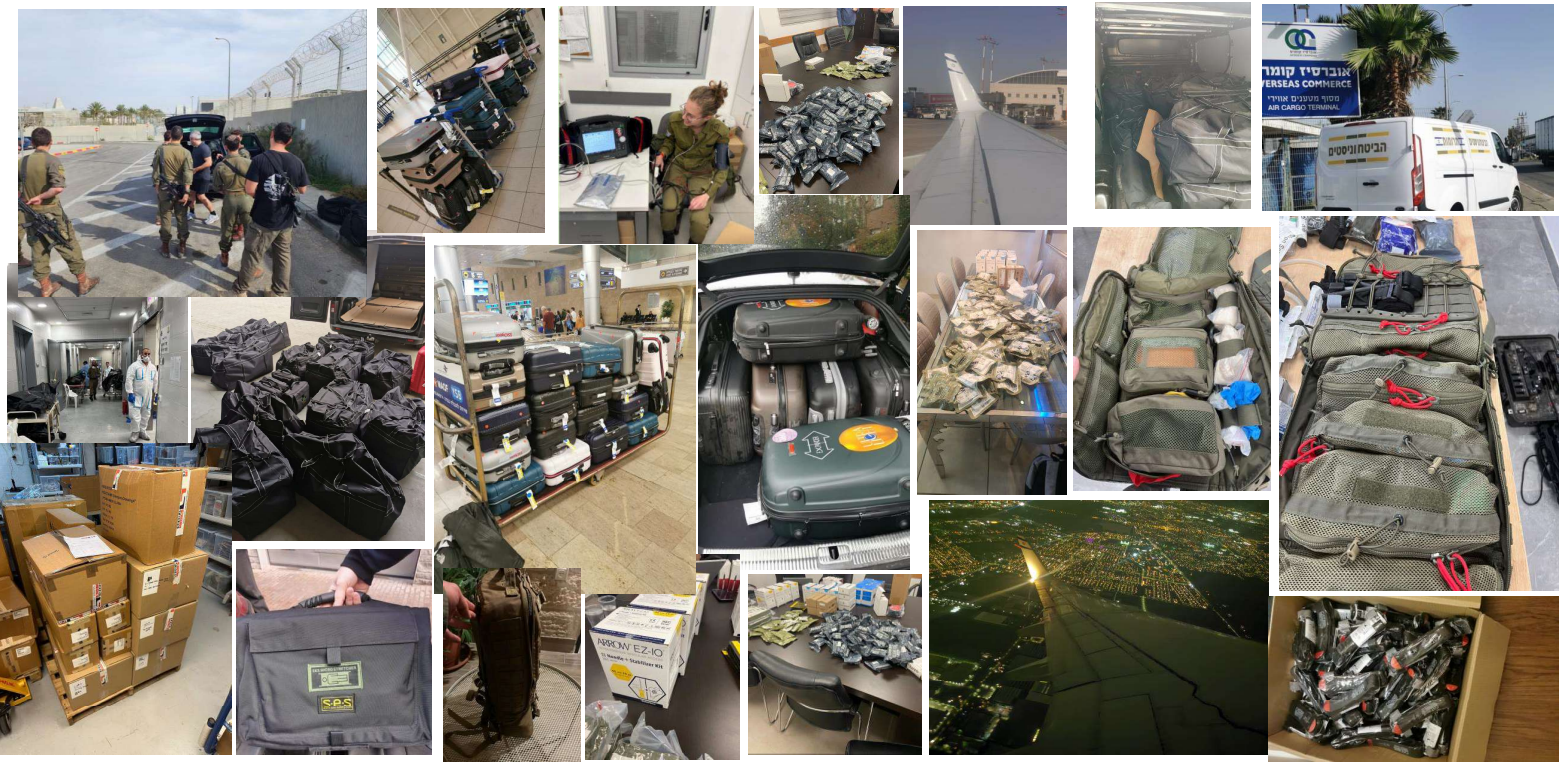

Thank-you letter:



To the dear friends from Jewish Community of Belgium and Their Friends from All Around the World

On behalf of my colleagues, combatant medical personal and the fierce warriors of "Yamas AYOSH", I would like to say thank you! Our great unit is in combat night and day for many years and has a specialty of getting face to face with an enemy, without them noticing until it is too late. With five casualties and numerous injured, it took time (as it did in all western world) to understand the importance of investing time and money in medicine adapted to the battlefield.

While these days, we get the essential equipment need to save lives and minimize injury severity, that equipment is standardized and that makes it barely fit for our special missions. The size of the paramedic bag, the weight of the bag itself, and the saving of it is excellent for a paramedic that goes to a war for several weeks or months, but in our kind of stealthy missions, light is right, and the fit must be perfect.

That is why your great donation of the M-10 paramedic bag, is lifesaving.

When venous access falls as it does in severe hemorrhage very often, paramedics need to get a line through the bone. We have the NIO device. It works well, but it is also bulky, and we are able to take only two each. With your donation of the EZ-IO device and needles, I already have taken out the two NIO I had and replaced them with 4 needles. Your generosity doubled all our paramedics efficiency in getting a root for administrating the lifesaving medication.

All patients that need to be ventilated need the paramedic to monitor the gases coming in and out of the patient to notice improvement or decline in their state. That is gold standard for all primary caretakers. The device we get from IDF is only able to tell me if carbon-dioxide is coming out, but with your loving care we will be able to measure the exact amount of this gas, see it as a graph and interpret the reasons and the threats. The EMMA device also has alarm mode that will pull my attention when the measurement is off and that alone could save a life of an operative, during a state of battle or mass casualty event.

You have also given is special active heating blankets, survival blankets and packing bandages, that are crucial in the state of bleeding. While stopping the bleed is the best way to save an injured warrior, we often cannot get to all the locations where the bleeding takes place. It is well known to the medical community that hypothermia (low body temperature) causes the system that build blood clots to fail. Hence, using your wide handed gifts, we will heat the patient, and that will help them bleed less and survive better. The packing bandages will allow us to get to the deep, dangerous bleedings that are common after improvised explosion device injuries or big caliber injuries to the pelvis, neck and femur.

Your appointed trusted man mr. [redacted] meticulously and selflessly build the perfect fit for our unit and brought your donation to me personally to make sure that it gets to me as soon as possible and hole. I have already taken it to battle and can tell you that the difference was felt throughout the mission.

Dear friends, your devotion is the exact reason why the Jewish people have survived the worst. Helping each other from the brotherly love is an ancient value as the stories of Abraham, Yaakov and Moses. Your love was needed in those difficult times, and with it we will be faster and stronger and smarter than those who wish to kill us all in the worst ways possible. We could never thank you enough, but we hope our fights will honor your devotion.
